

THE INTERNATIONAL OCEAN DISCOVERY PROGRAM (IODP, 2013–2024), was dedicated to advancing scientific understanding of Earth processes by sampling and observing subseafloor environments using novel sensors and experimental techniques. IODP's principal themes were climate, deep biosphere, planetary dynamics, and geohazards.

IODP members included the USA (NSF), Japan (MEXT), Europe (ECORD), People's Republic of China (MOST), Australia-New Zealand Consortium (ANZIC), India (MoES) and Korea (KIGAM).

Previous scientific ocean drilling phases included the Deep Sea Drilling Project (DSDP) Ocean Drilling Program (ODP), and Integrated Ocean Drilling Program (IODP).
